As the [CWRA National Conference](#), held June 5-8th in Canmore, Alberta, will be one of the first in-person event in some years for hydrological practitioners, we saw a great opportunity to bring Delft-FEWS users together. At the CWRA conference, Deltares will be organizing a workshop focused on sharing experiences and practical elements between Delft-FEWS users, providing you with the latest news on Delft-FEWS developments and having dialogue on guiding future development and research efforts.
