



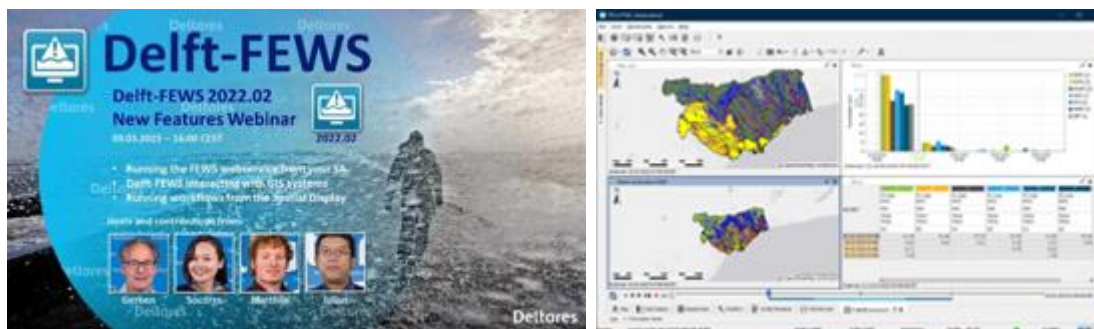
FEWS news: issue 2, 2023

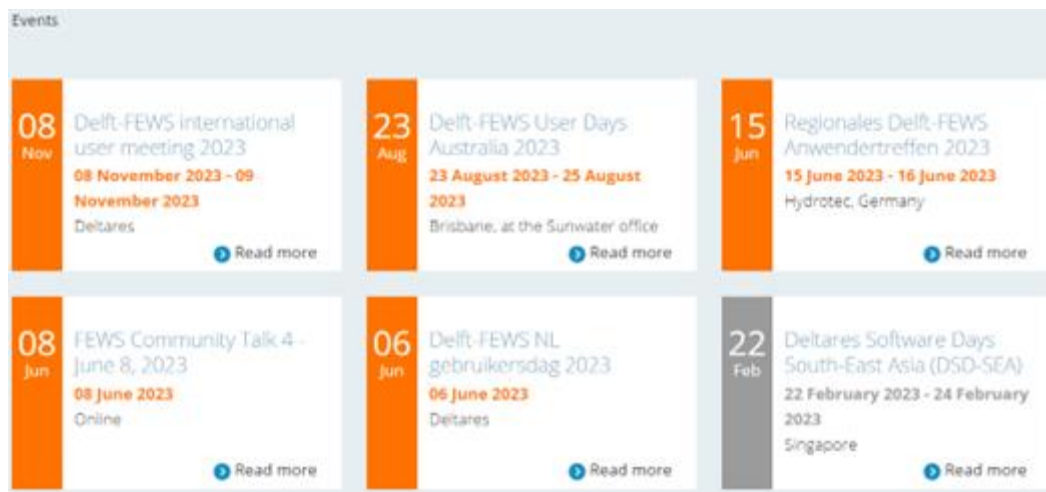


- The recording of the [FEWS Community Talk](#) about Forecast Verification is available on the portal, and the presentations are available for download.
